SAT, ACT & PSAT Combined Course

Two Enrollment Options

Class Dates and Descriptions

Session 1. SAT Math Sunday, July 8, 5:30-7:30 PM. When and how to use the calculator efficiently; Heart of Algebra focusing on the linear equations and systems; problem solving and data analysis; using process of elimination vs. guessing.

Session 2. Reading Comprehension Sunday, July 15, 5:30-7:30 PM. Evidence-based reading (SAT); interpreting data presented in informational graphics (SAT); key ideas integration of knowledge (ACT); using the previewing, skimming, & rereading techniques.

Session 3. English Language Test Sunday, July 22, 5:30-7:30 PM. Expression of Ideas – revising & editing passages; standard English conventions (sentence structure, usage, and punctuation).

Session 4. ACT Math Sunday, July 29, 5:30-7:30 PM. Differences between SAT and ACT; how to use the calculator efficiently. Interpreting the question; what to do when you simply don't know what to do!

Session 5. The Optional SAT & ACT Essays Sunday, Aug 5, 5:30-7:30 PM. Explain how an author builds the argument to persuade his/her audience; use of evidence, reasoning, and persuasive elements (SAT). Evaluate multiple perspective on a contemporary Issue; brainstorming & organizing information (ACT).

Session 6. Math & ACT Science Sunday, Aug 12, 5:30-7:30 PM. Data interpretation & the types of passages; revisiting time management; pacing for improved stamina.
